

Bursary Application Guidelines and Conditions

Murray Conservatorium (MC) is partially funded by the New South Wales Department of Education (DoE). DoE supports the inclusion of equity principles in the design and delivery of programs supported by the NSW Government and promotes equitable practices through adherence to established policies. Equity principles ensure that all persons have fair and reasonable access to the Department's funded programs. In this respect, Murray Conservatorium receives funding from DoE to provide fee relief, in the form of bursaries, for those students and families who are in genuine need of financial assistance.

► Guidelines

- A **Bursary Application Form** must be submitted to the office along with a 200 word summary outlining the student's commitment to music education and how this bursary will assist you or your child in being able to continue music education at MC.
- Only one application per family to be submitted (there is provision for up to 2 students on this form; please use an additional form if required)
- Adult students are invited to apply
- Applicants may be required to attend an interview
- Applications and the level of fee relief will be considered on an individual basis
- All applicant information will be treated in the strictest confidence
- Applications from prospective students may be submitted at any time
- Bursaries will be awarded for the remaining calendar year at the Conservatorium's discretion

► Conditions

Beneficiaries are required to

- Demonstrate strong commitment and satisfactory progress on their chosen instrument, voice or ensemble
- Advise the Conservatorium of any change in financial circumstances
- Bursaries are disbursed at the start of each term
- Applications for students seeking assistance for tuition in the year 2024 must be in by 5pm Friday 24 November 2023
